EASTER MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR 2024

WHAT MIGHT HELP in the process to “see and believe” in the resurrection experience is to leave behind what no longer serves to deepen one’s faith. In the second reading for Easter morning mass, Saint Paul takes the imagery of “a little bad yeast” that leavens the whole batch of dough, and warns us that this “little bit of yeast” can potentially corrupt the whole community of faith (1 Cor 5:6). Paul is referring to the Feast of Unleavened Bread that follows Passover in the Jewish calendar. His advice is clear: “Clear out the old yeast, so that you might become a fresh batch of dough, inasmuch as you are unleavened” (1 Cor 5:7).

May we celebrate this Easter feast not with the old yeast that inflates one’s ego, but with the unleavened bread that represents integrity and truth. In other words, to “see and believe” in the power of the resurrection requires humility. That is the start and end point for every person of faith. If Christians boast about anything today, let it be about the acceptance of humility in light of the mysteries we profess to believe, like the rising from the dead. The above reflection is like a New Year’s resolution, except for the church the new year begins with the renewal of Easter faith. Let this be a time newness, to see again, to release our grip on those long-held grudges from the past, and, perhaps most important, to renew our love for one another. I invite you to a renewal of humility as we embrace this Easter hope. – Fr. Victor Cancino, S.J.
